UNDERTAKING

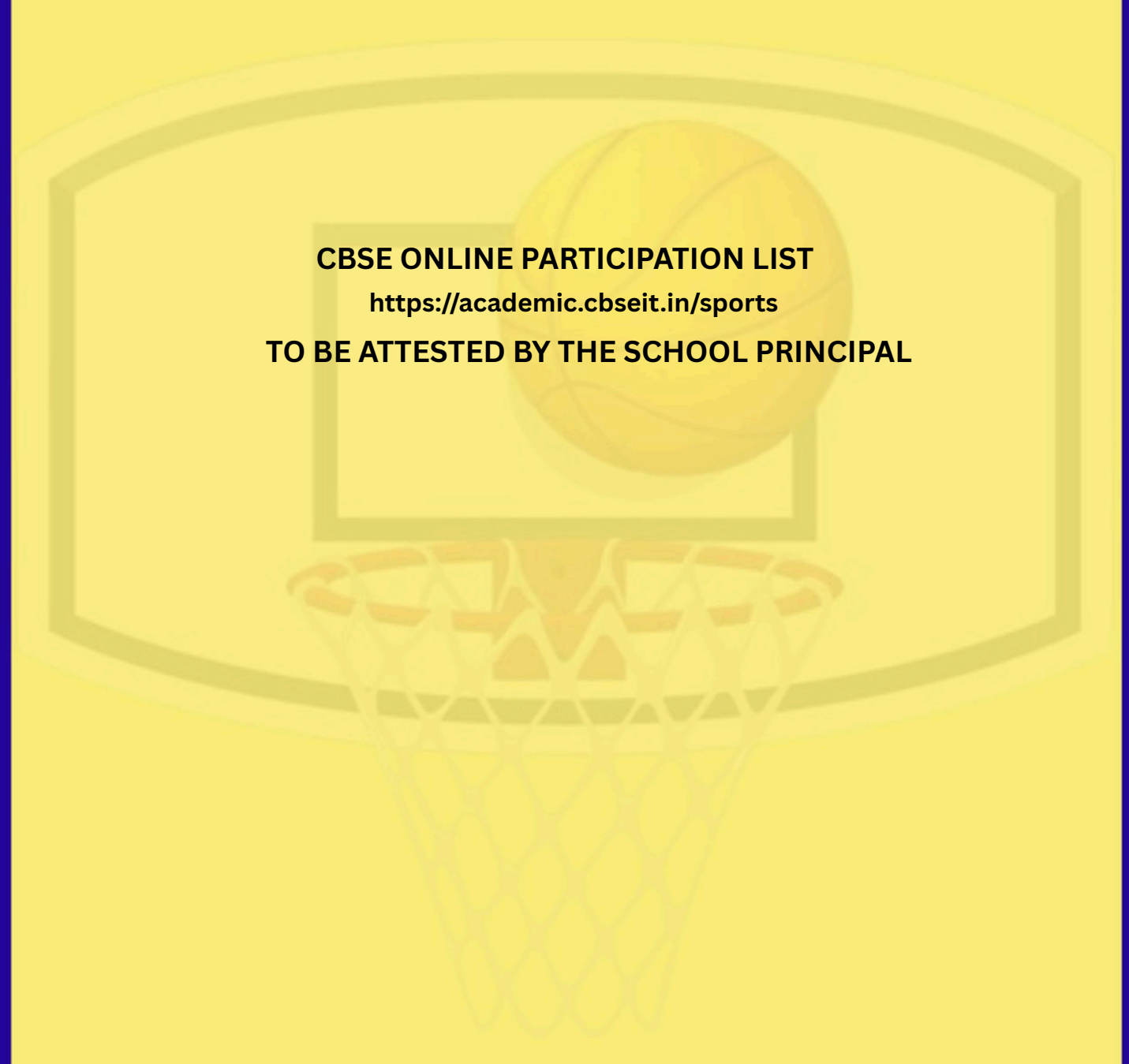

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/COACH/MANAGER)

1. All the teams must be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated/ authorized by the Principal of the participating school in writing.
2. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
3. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, such information must be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
4. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.

Participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.

The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid identity card issued by their school principal.

5. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

General / Mandatory Instructions

1. Taking part in Opening ceremony with school flag, march past & closing ceremony is mandatory for all schools and players.
2. Escort Coach/Manager shall be held responsible for their students' behavior manners and language; any default shall be reported to their school Principal/Management & to CBSE.
3. At the time of event in progress only eligible participants will be entitled to enter basketball arena, other players shall be expected to stay out of play arena.
4. Players must give their attendance to official 45 min prior to scheduled time of event.
5. It is mandatory for all coaches/managers/players to wear school identity card during days of meet irrespective of whether they are in or out of school campus.
6. It is mandatory for all the schools to deposit total amount for all the days of competition as per CBSE norms at the time of reporting.
7. Students' movement after 8:00 pm outside their accommodation room is strictly prohibited.
8. It is mandatory for all Coaches & Managers to stay with students in allotted accommodation/ room only.
9. Bringing or use of tobacco sachets, cigarettes, and liquor is strictly prohibited in school campus. If any coach/manager/student is found (drunk or smoking) in campus, his/her team shall be disqualified with immediate effect and same will be informed to CBSE/ their Principal for disciplinary action.
10. Only Vegetarian meals will be served in school campus.
11. The host school will not be responsible for any incident which happens out of school campus during outing of any coach/manager/team or players.

IMPORTANT: MANDATORY INSTRUCTIONS

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31st December of the year of competition

- (a) Please go through all CBSE norms of participation in this event only bonafide students with CBSE Reg. No. shall be eligible to participate in this event School tournaments/meets. Filling names of any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- (b) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- (c) Incomplete information or violation of CBSE norms of participation in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- (d) Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- (e) The original eligibility Proforma of the Athletes/Players/Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster/Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster/Zone level competition is over.
- (f) Medical check-up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the case of overage objection.
- (g) A player shall be under 14; 17; & 19 years of age on 31 Dec 2026.
 - 1. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2013
 - 2. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2010
 - 3. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008
- (h) All the supporting papers (original) verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- (i) The players' right to participate forfeits on failing to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
- (j) Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-

- (i) The documents for verification in original when asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
- (iv) To supply the eligibility Performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (v) Assurance Letter (As per Annexure-D)
- (vi) Travel Plan (As per Annexure-C)
- (vii) Participant's List (As per Annexure-A)

BASKET BALL GIRLS

1. The tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Basketball Federation of India with modifications wherever applicable.
2. The number of players representing a school shall not more than twelve.
3. All the matches at Cluster level shall be conducted on knock out basis. In case the number of teams is less, the Cluster level tournament too may be organized on league basis.
4. At National level, the matches shall be conducted on league cum knock out basis.
5. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.
6. In any match, played on knock out basis including the final, if there is a tie, extension of five minutes shall continue to be given till the game is decided.
7. In case of a tie in matches played on league basis, the following procedure shall decide the winner, runner-up etc.
 1. The team which has beaten the other team in the league matches shall be the winner
 2. The tie between more than two teams will be decided on the basis of points scored and points against. The team securing the greatest quotient will be the winner. The points scored for and against shall be counted only in the matches played between the teams in tie.
 3. If the tie still persists, the formula will be points scored points against. The team with highest difference is declared the winner. Again, the scoring will be counted in the matches played between the teams in tie.
8. The number "6" size Ball will be used for GIRLS matches.
9. A team shall be prepared to play more than two matches in a day.
10. All participating teams shall carry with them two sets of playing kit (uniform), one set of light color and the other set of dark color.
11. The team that has been named first in the fixture, will sit on the left side of the Official's Table, and shall score towards the right side of the court.
12. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
13. Protest if any, must be submitted in writing along with the fee within 20 min after the declaration of the result.
14. In case a team intends to protest against the opposite team; the Captain of team that intends to protest, must sign the score sheet.
15. In case a team forfeits & walks out of the court without completing the match, it shall lose the right to submit any protest and shall be debarred from rest of the tournament.
